

Aug 29th -2026 Race Recap .

Cagle Racing Automotive LLC, BLUE RIDGE Outlaw Late Models, powered by **Newsome/Raceway Parts Network, Raceway Chevrolet, Chevrolet Performance** and 3D Dirt Works.

Becoming only the 2nd driver to pick up back-to-back series wins in 2026, Bryan Mullis returned to BROLM Victory Lane by prevailing over a strong field of 29 entries Saturday night at **Harris Speedway** to score \$3000 and his 3rd victory of the season.

Fast Qualifiers John Price (Group b and Blake Craft (Group A) led the field to the green in the **ProFabrication, Inc** Quick 8 Dash. Price would parlay his Fast Time Honors into a dash win over Craft and Mullis. Heat Race Winners Dillon Brown, Dan Breuer, Anthony Sanders, and those transferring from each heat joined the Top 8 from the dash to set the starting lineup. Making his long-awaited return to the series on the familiar grounds of the Rutherfordton oval, Price set the pace early with the rest of the field in pursuit. He would lead early only to fight a tight car as the laps passed by. While Craft and Mullis dueled for position to challenge Price, a cagy and seasoned veteran was methodically making his way toward the front. Dan Breuer, from the 10th starting position, was rallying into contention. While the veteran Breuer made his presence felt, 2026 BROLM Feature Winner Layton Sullivan was turning his night around as well from being in the Last Chance Qualifier to challenging for a Top 10 finish. Mullis, last week's winner at Lancaster, surged into the lead looking to continue his recent momentum. Numerous storylines were emerging within the race itself and the upcoming 2026 **Chevrolet Performance CT525 Nationals** coming in September. Mullis would capture the win followed by an impressive performance by Craft with Breuer rounding out the podium followed by Austin Mintz and Jacob Brown.

Braden Jones secured a Top 10 and remains atop the standings and though the next BROLM series event is scheduled for September 19th at **Lake View Motor Speedway**, a massive weekend of action awaits the teams as the 2026 CT 525 Nationals are set for September 10th – September 12th at Harris Speedway! Concord, North Carolina's Matt Long looks to defend his 2025 CT 525 Nationals Championship, but an impressive list of challengers is already registered to challenge for the 2026 Championship.
