

June 13th Race Recap Harris Speedway / Charlie Blanton Memorial.

Returning to the winning form that delivered him the 2024 BROLM Series Championship, Brandon Dockery made a long-awaited return to Victory Lane as he bested the field Saturday night at Harris Speedway to capture a \$3000 triumph!

Anthony Sanders and Championship Leader Braden Jones paced the teams in Group 1 Qualifying while Dockery and Terry Caples Jr topped the charts in Group 2. As the drivers proceeded to the grid for the ProFabrication, Inc Quick 8 Dash, Jones was surprisingly and unfortunately unable to join the field. This relegated Jones to a 4th Row starting spot for the feature. Dockery edged Sanders in the Pro Fabrication Quick 8 Dash as Bryan Mullis and Layton Sullivan (looking for his 3rd consecutive win) secured the 3rd and 4th positions locking both drivers into a Row 2 Starting Spot for the 40 Lap Main Event.

The duel for the top spot erupted right from the drop of the green flag as Dockery, Sanders, and Mullis waged war looking to secure the highly coveted track position out in front of the field. Powering through the middle line off Turn 4 while splitting in between Sanders and Mullis, Dockery blasted into the race lead. Jones, attempting to rebound from the misfortune in the Quick 8 Dash, was rallying back towards the front as Dockery continued to hold off Mullis and others at the front of the field. Three and Four Wide Racing continued until a caution flag involving Sanders collected a handful of his fellow competitors, derailing all their efforts for a Top 5. Jones and Mullis refused to let the leader out of their crosshairs, but they could not overtake Dockery as he would maintain control the rest of the way to introduce yet another new face to the 2026 BROLM Race Winners List!

After an intense month of competition, the BROLM teams will get a couple of weeks off as a blockbuster RED, WHITE, & BLUE RIDGE doubleheader awaits them on Independence Weekend with a trip to Gastonia's Carolina Speedway on Friday July 3rd and a visit to Lake View Motor Speedway on Saturday July 4th! Via his rally to a runner-up finish, Jones (275 points) leaves Harris with an 18-point lead over Caples Jr (257) as Sanders (232), Sullivan (226), and Mullis (225) all remain within striking distance.
